PORT OF BENTON SPECIAL COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES OCTOBER 25, 2017

- A. CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. at the Port of Benton Commission Meeting Room, 3250 Port of Benton Boulevard, Richland, Washington. Present were Commissioners Jane F. The Port plans on borrowing \$500,000 in 2017 and \$3,500,000 in 2018 from a line of credit.
