#### Port of Benton Scope of Work

Prevailing wages apply for this project and a Wage Compliance Form will be required to be submitted with the bid.

#### Contractor and Sub-contractors must be on Port of Benton Small Works Roster.

As of July 1, 2019, all businesses are required to have LNI training before bidding and /or performing work on public works projects unless the business is exempt.

It is the responsibility of the Contractor to make certain that all sub-contractors have had LNI Training.

Contractors must be able to provide proof of insurance, license and bonding.

- Contractors must be able to Provide General Liability Insurance with a \$2,000,000.00
   Liability naming the Port of Benton as additional insured and as the Certificate Holder including the name of the Project in the Description.
- Contractor is required to obtain a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond for all Projects over \$50,000. (Contractor can ask to have 10% retainage held in lieu of bond for projects under \$150,000)
- Contractor is required to have a business license for the City in which the work is being performed.
- Contractor is required to give the Port a copy of any specialty license for projects that include electrical, plumbing, and/or HVAC.

Contractor is responsible for verifying permit requirements and for obtaining any permits needed for this project.

Contractor and Sub-Contractor are responsible for filing Intents to pay Prevailing Wage and Affidavits of Wages Paid with Washington State Department of Labor and Industries.

 Intents must be submitted and approved prior to beginning work for Contractor and Sub-Contractors. All costs incurred in the filing of Intents and Affidavits are the responsibility of the contractor.

Affidavits must be submitted and approved prior to final payment being made.

Projects over \$100,000 will need to have Commission Approval for Acceptance of Work.

#### Port of Benton Scope of Work

A Notice of Completion will be sent to Labor & Industries, Employment Security, and Department of Revenue for Release of Retainage.

 A Retainage of 5% will be held for at least 45 days and until LNI, ESD, and DOR send releases.

The procurement of these services will be in accordance with applicable federal, state, and local laws, and Port policies and procedures. The Port reserves the right to reject any and all Proposals.


The Port reserves the right to waive any minor irregularity and/or reject any and all firms and cancel the procurement.



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#### GENERAL CONSTRUCTION NOTES

- 1. THESE PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, AND REFERENCED DOCUMENTS SHALL BE USED TO CONSTRUCT THE IMPROVEMENTS SHOWN. REFERENCED DOCUMENTS INCLUDE THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (WSDOT) STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROAD, BRIDGE, AND MUNICIPAL CONSTRUCTION (CURRENT EDITION), WSDOT STANDARD PLANS, CITY OF RICHLAND STANDARD PLANS, AND THE MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (MUTCD).
- 2. ALL EXISTING UTILITIES SHOWN ON THE PLANS ARE SHOWN WITH AS MUCH ACCURACY AS POSSIBLE, BASED ON AVAILABLE INFORMATION. SOME DISCREPANCIES AND OMISSIONS IN LOCATION, TYPE, AND SIZE SHOULD BE EXPECTED TO OCCUR. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOCATING AND PROTECTING ALL EXISTING UTILITIES IN AND AROUND THE WORK AREAS. BOTH PRIVATE AND PUBLIC POWER, WATER, IRRIGATION, TELEPHONE, GAS, CABLE, AND WASTEWATER SHALL BE INCLUDED. ANY DISCREPANCIES BETWEEN THE DESIGN SHEETS AND EXISTING CONDITIONS SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE ENGINEER.
- 3. UNLESS OTHERWISE APPROVED BY THE CITY, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE CONTINUOUS ACCESS FOR EMERGENCY VEHICLES, LOCAL BUSINESSES, RESIDENCES, AND THEIR RESPECTIVE DRIVEWAYS. ACCESS SHALL ALSO BE PROVIDED FOR MAIL DELIVERY, SANITATION, AND OTHER MUNICIPAL/PRIVATE UTILITY PROVIDERS.
- 4. SAW CUT ALL EXISTING ASPHALT AND CONCRETE WHERE JOINTS WITH NEW CONSTRUCTION WILL OCCUR. DOUBLE SAW CUT REQUIRED FOR ALL LOCATIONS.
- 5. IRRIGATION AND LANDSCAPING EXISTS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT THE PROJECT. WHERE IMPACTED BY CONSTRUCTION, THE LANDSCAPING AND IRRIGATION SHALL BE REESTABLISHED PER BID ITEMS AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. REPAIRS SHALL BE MADE WITH EXISTING MATERIALS OR EQUAL REPLACEMENTS AS NECESSARY. IRRIGATION SYSTEMS SHALL BE REPAIRED WITHIN 5 DAYS OF DISTURBANCE.
- 6. THROUGHOUT THE PROJECT AREA, MAILBOXES, TRASH RECEPTACLES, FENCES, SIGNS, UTILITIES, ETC. EXIST NEAR THE CURB LINE THAT MAY BE IMPACTED BY CONSTRUCTION. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT, TEMPORARILY RELOCATE, AND REINSTALL THESE FACILITIES WHERE IMPACTED BY CONSTRUCTION, THIS SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO THE WORK BEING COMPLETED. THE CONTRACTOR IS ADVISED THAT THE LOCATION OF FENCES, TREES, LANDSCAPING, AND OTHER OBJECTS, IF SHOWN IN THE PLANS, IS PROVIDED SOLELY TO PROVIDE WARNING OF THE PROBABLE LOCATION OF SAID OBJECTS AND MAY NOT BE PRECISE OR COMPLETE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SATISFY HIMSELF AS TO THE EXACT LOCATIONS BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH WORK.
- 7. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL KEEP THE SITE IN A NEAT AND ORDERLY CONDITION. ALL TRASH GENERATED BY THE CONTRACTOR'S OPERATIONS SHALL BE PICKED UP AT THE END OF EACH DAY. EQUIPMENT, VEHICLES, AND MATERIALS SHALL BE STAGED EITHER OFF SITE OR ALONG CLOSED PORTIONS OF THE ROADWAY.
- 8. PROTECT AND AVOID DAMAGE TO ALL PROPERTY OUTSIDE THE PORT RIGHT-OF-WAY, INCLUDING STRUCTURES, RETAINING WALLS, TREES, IRRIGATION SYSTEMS, WALKWAYS, AND LANDSCAPES.
- 9. ALL DRIVEWAY LOCATIONS SHALL BE STAKED BY THE CONTRACTOR AND APPROVED BY THE OWNER PRIOR TO EXCAVATION AND CONSTRUCTION.
- 10. ALL WATER SERVICE, IRRIGATION SERVICE, FIBER CROSSING, AND SEWER SERVICE LOCATIONS AT CURB CROSSINGS SHALL BE MARKED WITH A 2" HIGH 'W', 'I', 'F', OR 'S' INSCRIBED BY STAMPING THE FACE OF THE NEW CURB.
- 11. ALL KNOWN UTILITY CROSSINGS SHALL BE POTHOLED PRIOR TO INSTALLATION OF NEW UTILITIES. CONFLICTS SHALL BE IMMEDIATELY REPORTED TO THE ENGINEER TO ALLOW FOR ADJUSTMENTS IN LINE AND/OR GRADE.



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#### **GENERAL TRAFFIC CONTROL NOTES**

- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL VEHICULAR AND PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC CONTROL. WSDOT STANDARD PLANS SHALL BE USED AS A GUIDE FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT DETAILED TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS AND OBTAIN APPROVAL FROM THE PORT OF BENTON PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION. ALL SIGNING SHALL COMPLY WITH THE MUTCD AND ALL TRAFFIC OPERATIONS MUST BE ACCEPTABLE TO THE PORT OF BENTON.
- 2. APPROPRIATE METHODS OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC CONTROL, INCLUDING FLAGGERS, SHALL BE USED BY THE CONTRACTOR, TO THE EXTENT DEEMED NECESSARY BY THE CONTRACTOR OR THE ENGINEER, TO PROTECT WORKERS OR THIRD PARTIES. 





